LdM HOUSING POLICIES AND RULES

The LdM Housing Policies and Rules stated herein are valid for the entire duration of the rental period and apply to all students occupying LdM student apartments.

LdM Housing Policies

1. The rental period begins on Housing Check-In and ends at 12:00 p.m. on Housing Check-Out and may not be presumptively or tacitly extended.
2. A security deposit is required for each housing reservation. If there is no damage to the apartment and its contents caused by student's irresponsibility or negligence, or excessive use of utilities, the security deposit will be fully refunded.
3. The housing rent balance is due no later than 30 days before the Housing Check-In date, unless an alternate, written arrangement has been approved by LdM. If payment is not received by the deadline, LdM reserves the right to refuse housing to the student.
4. Rent and utilities are paid by LdM to the apartment landlords. The sum paid is based on average consumption of the utilities (water, gas, electricity). Students will be charged for excessive use of utilities.
5. LdM Housing Coordination reserves the right to change housing assignments before Housing Check-In and/or during the rental period. (In the latter case, changes are made only for reasons such as health or other conditions seriously affecting the general welfare of the apartment residents.) LdM Housing Coordination must review and approve any changes to roommate and/or housing assignments, and will do so only in situations involving extreme circumstances.
6. LdM Housing Coordination pre-inspects all apartments prior to the Housing Check-In date. Subsequent housing inspections may take place at any other time deemed necessary by LdM Housing Coordination, with advance notice. Additionally, during semester programs, some randomly chosen apartments will be inspected in the middle of the term.
7. The landlord has the right of entry to the apartment with prior notice (except in an emergency) to verify that the terms of the contract are respected, to show it to future students or purchasers, and for general maintenance.
8. All apartments will be inspected after the students' departure by LdM Housing Coordination and landlords. The cost for damage to the apartment and its contents caused by student's irresponsibility or negligence and/or any special cleaning required will be charged to the students. (Neither LdM nor the landlord will be responsible for personal property left by students in the apartment after the housing check out date.)
9. LdM will withhold the transcript or Certificate of Academic Performance of students with outstanding debts for excessive use of utilities, apartment damages, or other charges referenced above.
10. Upon any violation/s of the LdM Housing Rules, LdM Rules of Conduct, and/or LdM Academic Regulations, the LdM Dean of Students may apply sanctions in accordance with the enforcement of those Rules and Regulations. LdM also reserves the right to evict students from apartments based on any such violation/s. In the case of eviction, the student is liable for the full housing cost (deposit and rent).
NOTE: In accordance with the Italian law, if an overnight guest is found in an LdM apartment, depending on the size of the apartment and the length of the stay, local authorities have the right to impose fines.

LdM Housing Rules

1. Students must maintain full-time enrollment at LdM and actively attend courses to remain in LdM housing.
2. Students may move in to LdM housing only on the designated Housing Check-In date and must vacate housing by 12:00 PM on the Check-Out date.
3. Students are not permitted to change housing assignment or roommates, or to stay in another LdM housing accommodation without receiving written permission from LdM.
4. Students must report any pre-existing damages or complaints in writing (on the LdM Damage Form) to LdM Housing Coordination by the deadline stated on the form. Any items not listed on the form will be assumed to be in satisfactory condition.
5. Students are responsible for the cost of ordinary maintenance (light bulbs, broken keys, windows, clogged drains, etc.). Students are held individually responsible for damages or violations in their assigned room and collectively responsible for damages or violations that occur in the shared common areas of their apartment.
6. Students agree to keep the apartment, building entrance, and stairs in a clean, orderly, and safe condition. Note the following:
 - a) Bicycles are not permitted in the apartment building;
 - b) Hanging/installation of anything on apartment walls (with nails, tape, pushpins, etc.) is not permitted;
 - c) Pets are not permitted;
 - d) At departure, the apartment must be left clean, orderly, and free of personal property.
7. Students may not smoke in any LdM apartment/apartment building. All LdM apartments are NON-SMOKING.
8. Students MUST respect neighbors and avoid disturbing them in any way. Students must refrain from making loud noise, hosting parties, moving/adding furniture, and/or wearing heels, boots or other heavy-soled shoes in the apartment.
9. Students are STRICTLY PROHIBITED from the following:
 - a) Subletting or lending of the leased premises is expressly forbidden. Only the undersigned lessee and assigned apartment-mates are permitted to occupy the apartment;
 - b) Allowing overnight guests (for safety reasons and according to Italian law);
 - c) Providing apartment access to non-students. Anyone doing so is responsible for the non-student's actions, including any violations of the LdM Housing Rules and their repercussions.
10. Students are responsible for the appropriate use of their designated apartment keys and should note the following:
 - a) Students should not write their home address on any part of their keys or keychain;
 - b) At NO time should keys be lent out to non-residents;
 - c) Lost keys are a serious matter and not only impact the safety of the resident who lost the key, but also the safety and security of roommates. Therefore, if the student shall be separated from the apartment keys for any reason (loss, theft, lent out, etc.), it must be reported to LdM immediately. The student alone shall be responsible for the cost of replacement keys and the locks, which is costly in Italy;
 - d) It is necessary to double lock (deadbolt) the apartment door when entering/exiting the apartment, as doors do not lock automatically. Always close and lock the windows before leaving the apartment;
 - e) Unauthorized duplication or purchase of keys is not permitted.
