GENERAL POLICIES

Admissions

Applicants must complete and submit all the required application materials. (See checklist on Page 1.) Additionally,

- · Students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or better.
- Students must be at least entering their sophomore year.
- Students must have upheld good academic and judicial stand-ing with their home institutions, if applicable.
- · Students must be at least 18 years of age.
- Students must be in a good medical/psychological condition to succeed in the program.

Proof of English Proficiency In order to learn effectively, students are expected to be independent English users with proficiency in listening, speaking, reading, and writing. Non-native English speakers are required to demonstrate that they have reached the high intermediate level in English language skills, with certification or other evidence equivalent to the following minimum overall TOEFL scores: Paper Based Test 550+, Computer Based Test 213+, or Internet Based Test 80+.

Year-Long Program Specifics

Students may enroll in a selected year-long Certificate Program for the complete academic year (fall and spring semesters). The first semester of each year-long program is offered in the fall only and the second semester is offered in the spring only.

Students with prior knowledge of the selected field of study may be admitted to the non-beginning semester of a first-year Certificate, after submitting a portfolio of their work to be assessed and approved. The second semester of each year-long Certificate takes place in the spring semester only, prices and deadline are available on request.

Year-long Certificate Program students may choose to start with the Certificate and move into the Professional/Advanced Certificate, completing a two-year program.

Students applying for the Professional/Advanced Certificate Program must provide proof of a solid background in the selected area. An admissions committee will review the application and accept only those students who meet the entry requirements. Please note that if you select but do not meet the requirements for the Professional/Advanced Certificate Program, you will have the option of being admitted to the Certificate Program.

All Certificate Programs are offered in Florence only, except for the Certificate in International Conflict Transformation which is offered in Rome.

Please note that once you arrive at LdM you will not be allowed to switch Programs or Location.

Students must successfully complete the entire course sequence to receive a Certificate or Professional/ Advanced Certificate.

YEAR-LONG CERTIFICATE REGISTRATION POLICIES

- The LdM Certificate and Professional/Advanced Certificate courses have already been determined by LdM. Students cannot change their courses or sections.
- Students may attend only the courses listed on their Official Registration form. Auditing is not allowed.
- Attendance is mandatory for all courses.
- Students applying to a non-beginning level of the selected program will take a level test for each course of the chosen semester. Students who fail one or more level tests will have the option of enrolling in the beginning level of the Certificate or switching to the Study Abroad Program and paying the difference in tuition.
- Students pre-registered for a non-beginning course, including Italian, must check the LdM Academic Catalog to make sure they meet all the prerequisites. A placement test will be administered to confirm the students' level. As a result of the placement test, LdM reserves the right to move students into a different level.
- In the event of insufficient enrollment in particular courses (especially at the higher levels), LdM reserves the right to adjust the balance of teaching/ open studio hours.
- Mid-terms and final exams will be given only on the scheduled days that appear on each course syllabus and will not be moved under any circumstances, including illness, travel plans, family matters, etc.

- Exams are scheduled during class times, so more than one may be administered on the same day.
- Students are not allowed to make up any assessed in-class activities they have missed (including but not limited to quizzes, tests, etc.) under any circumstances, including illness, travel plans, family matters. etc.
- LdM does not offer Pass/Fail grades or Incompletes, only letter grades. All classes registered for and grades received will appear on each student's final transcript. Students are responsible for understanding the LdM grading system and their home institution's minimum grade requirement for the transfer of credit. Detailed information about grading/evaluation can be found in the specific course syllabi.
- The Certificate program is comprised of a series of courses that have been determined by LdM, as a complete learning experience in the field. All of these courses must be completed as part of the program. Students will be granted the Certificate or Professional/Advanced Certificate upon successful completion of the course sequence.
 Students who do not successfully complete the course sequence will receive a transcript only.
- Students with documented learning disabilities will be subject to local educational standards, and therefore may not be provided with the same accommodations offered by their home institution.

- However, based on current and official documentation of the disability, LdM will provide assistance to these students. It is each student's responsibility to provide this documentation within the deadline.
- Students must retain full-time status. Students relying on financial aid are responsible to know if they are required to be enrolled in a minimum number of courses/hours.
- LdM reserves the right to withhold the certificate/ academic record and/or housing deposit of students who violate contract agreements related to housing and/or academic issues (i.e. any balance or debt incurred) and/or whose behavior is considered detrimental towards the institute and other students.

SEMESTER CERTIFICATE REGISTRATION POLICIES

- The Semester Certificate courses have already been determined by LdM and students cannot change the course selection.
- Core courses or sections cannot be changed. Only
 one track course can be changed upon arrival at LdM,
 choosing from the list of approved track courses and
 depending on course availability. Section changes
 are not allowed for track or core courses. Any track
 course change is only allowed during the first week of
 classes, before the Final Registration deadline. All
 course change requests must be supported by a
 strong academic reason.
- Students may attend only the courses listed on their Official Registration form. Auditing is not allowed.
- Students will be required to take a level test for each course that includes a prerequisite. Students who fail one or more level tests will have the option of enrolling in the Study Abroad Program and paying the difference in tuition.
- In the event of insufficient enrollment in particular courses (especially at the higher levels), LdM reserves the right to adjust the balance of teaching/open studio hours.

- Applicants to the Semester Certificates may be asked to provide an alternative site and alternative courses (if applicable), depending on enrollment demand for the selected term.

ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS

- The LdM Certificate classes are intensive and practical, so course attendance is a primary requirement for a responsible learning experience. Absences will also be counted during the first week of class.
- Punctuality is mandatory. Students must arrive in class on time: any lateness, leaving class during the lesson without notice, not showing up on time after the break or leaving early will impact the participation and final grade.
- Students are responsible for keeping track of their absences and for catching up on any missed work.
- Make-up classes are always mandatory as part of the course program.
- If a class occasionally creates conflict with another class, the student is required to inform both instructors in advance.
- · Students will receive an "F" on each exam they miss.

- Absences will also be counted during the first days of class unless students added the class during the add/drop period. For no reason (i.e. travel plans, family matters etc.) will absences be excused.
- Students who leave LdM before the end of the term must fill out an Official Withdrawal Request form and return it to their advisor. Students who submit the form by the "W" Withdrawal deadline will receive a "W" for each non-completed course. Students who submit the form by the "W/F" Withdrawal deadline will receive a "W/F" for each non-completed course. Students who leave LdM without submitting the form will receive an "F" in each non-completed course. In all cases, students will not be eligible for credits or receive a refund.
- Students who absent themselves from courses will have their final grade penalized as indicated on the following table:
