TENTATIVE COURSE SCHEDULE

Classes start **Mon January 4** - Classes end **Monday January 25** , 2021

PLEASE NOTE

- 1) Each course includes **15 sessions from MON Jan 4 to MON Jan 25**, running **MON- FRI**, with the exception of the **final exam**, which will take place on **MONDAY January 25th**.
- 2) **There will be no class on WED Jan 6th due to the National Public Holiday: Epiphany.**
- 3) Each class takes place within the timeframes indicated below at CET-Central European Time/ Italy Rome time. Attending these sessions is a mandatory requirement.
- 4) Each online session consists of various modules including live lessons, student lounge and recorded lessons. Other audio-visual material will also be used (such as virtual tours, guest speakers, film excerpts, etc.) depending on the nature of the course. Daily/Weekly extra time is required to complete individual homework
- 5) The scheduled time frames are based on Central European Time GMT+1 ([find your time here](#)) and have been optimized to accommodate students from different time zones. Each student is required to calculate the matching local time zone and must be available to remotely join all sessions as scheduled on the syllabus.
- 6) For some courses students must be equipped with specific tools and materials, as illustrated in the syllabus, prior to starting class.
